And the lady that joined me in my lane as she was texting. She looked

angry when I honked my horns at her for some reason. Now these are just a few instances where my right-of-way has been violated. Had I not been observant and watching my surroundings, I might not be typing this little article. We as riders need to be focused and not distracted ourselves in order to survive. If you think about it though, our Gold Wings can provide numerous opportunities for distraction. Do you have to look down at the tank control panel to change radio channels or go to the weather channel or can you do this without taking your focus off the road? Most of us will agree that taking on the phone while driving can be distracting, but what about our CB? It is a great communication tool, but should be used when conditions allow its safe operation. All the bells and whistles are real nice to have when out riding, we just have to remember when to use them and not let them become another distraction.

1800 Video

This is a video on doing a remove and install on a rear tire on an 1800 that could be done on a roadside if necessary. Download the video and save it on your computer, the file is 18.1 mb in size.

Pretty good video, I did notice 2 things I want to mention, I'm *pretty sure* you aren't supposed to use anything on the wheel nuts, no lube or anti-seize, I could be wrong about that, but I don't think so.

When setting the bike back up, put it in gear first, to keep it from rolling, he shows this in the video, but it needs emphasis, make sure you put the sidestand down before setting it upright. This is also a good primer on how to stand a Wing back up if it falls over, if someone doesn't know how to do it, and it doesn't require a big guy to do it.
